Disabled Person Parking Permits

A parking privilege is granted by the Department of Licensing when an applicant meets the criteria listed below. The license plates, placards and identification card are issued as an identifier to law enforcement, parking enforcement, private business, or anyone who needs to know that a person has the right to park a vehicle in a disabled person parking area.

Eligibility:

People qualify for disabled parking placard if at least one of the following apply:

- Cannot walk 200 feet without stopping to rest
- Have limited walking ability because of arthritic, neurological or orthopedic conditions
- Have such severe disability that they cannot walk without help from another person or the use of a brace, cane, prosthetic device, wheelchair, or similar device
- Use portable oxygen
- Are legally blind with limited mobility
- Are severely restricted by lung disease and your expiratory respiratory volume when measured by spirometry is less than 1 liter/second or the arterial oxygen tension is less than 60 mm/hg on room air at rest
- Have a cardiovascular disease or cardiac condition to the extent that your functional limitations are classified as Class III or IV under standards accepted by the American Heart Association
- Have acute sensitivity to automobile emissions that limits or impacts or impairs their ability to walk and is comparable in severity to the above conditions – the severity must be documented by physician, physician assistant, or advanced registered nurse practitioner
- Have acute sensitivity to light associated with a form of porphyria that would significantly benefit from a decrease in exposure to light

Permit applications must be completed by your doctor, physician assistant, or licensed registered nurse practitioner. You must renew your permanent privileges every five years. Temporary privileges are good for six months.
